OUR MISSION...

Friends of the Morton Parks was organized to promote the interests of the community of Morton, foster community stewardship and pride by enlisting volunteers, promote the social, cultural and recreational well-being of the City's residents and visitors, lessen the burdens of the City of Morton in maintaining, operating, enhancing and improving the City of Morton parks and recreational facilities, through the realization of projects and programs which support its cultural and charitable pursuits.



ACHIEVEMENTS

Six months into 2018 and we are off to a great start. The Spaghetti Dinner Fundraiser was a success. We served over 80 dinners and had approximately 100 people attend. We picked up several new members and our ranks now number thirty-five. Entertainment provided by the Scogin family packed the room and was standing room only.

We had our first Hanging Flower Basket sales event. This activity was conducted by the Chamber of Commerce in the past so was not on our radar. However, the Chamber chose not to sell baskets this year and when people started asking questions and wanting baskets we picked up the reigns. We quickly organized, contacted the nursery and sold 150 baskets. Fertilizer is still available and can be purchased at Security State Bank.

We assisted in cleaning up Jubilee Park and helped The Morton Coop preschool with their annual Easter egg hunt and hosted a project for the first annual City Cleanup sponsored by the Morton Police Department and Reserve Police Association. The latter is still a work in progress as we removed the weedy bark from in front of the Lyle Building. We still must replace the bark with something – it looks like rock will likely be the choice.

The second year of the Farmers Market is off to a great start. We opened earlier this year, so vendors could among other things sell plant and vegetable starts. The season started with only two vendors, but the vendor numbers have increased as the weather has warmed, and gardens have begun producing. I encourage you to support our market. Vendors need to know that we will support them, so they have an incentive to make our market home.

PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES

In addition to the Farmer's Market, we have four "Movie Under the Stars" events planned. The movies and dates will be "Spiderman Homecoming" on July 21; "The Sandlot" on Aug. 4; "Kong Skull Island" on Aug. 18; and "Star Wars Rogue One" on Sept. 1. In keeping with our mission of improving the quality of life for our residents and visitors, the movies will be free -- just bring your own blanket. We will also have concessions for purchase. There has also been some discussion about doing music in the park. If you are a musician or know of someone who might be interested in performing in the park, please reach out to us.

The FOMP 2nd annual Holiday Bazaar is planned for November 16 &17 and will again be held at the Lyle Community Building. We don't anticipate any changes being implemented as last year seemed to go very well. We asked the vendors what they liked and didn't like and most of the comments were very supportive. One common comment that will likely bring about one change is that our tables were too small. We will likely allow the vendors to bring their own tables and if they wish to rent tables from us they will be able to do so at a nominal fee. Also, there were a few suggestions to include Sunday as well.

In October, we will be conducting a Paint your Pumpkin activity. Children will be provided art supplies and a pumpkin which they will be able to paint however they feel inspired. Pumpkin plants are in the ground growing and I am already beginning to see flower ovaries forming on the pumpkin plants.

We would like to partner with other groups on their projects and activities provided they are consistent with our overall mission.
